Academics

• Teachers at both campuses will be completing a data dive (Richfield Campus 7/15, Bloomington Campus 8/8) to analyze routine interims and the Minnesota Comprehensive Data from the 21-22 school year in order to determine patterns and guidance for future planning and instruction.
