<u>Mission</u>: Seven Hills Preparatory Academy engages students in a rigorous Classical education, designed to prepare *each one* for strong citizenship and life-long learning.

ACADEMICS

- We accepted a donation from the Eagles Club of Bloomington for \$750 to fulfill some additional art projects/materials requested by our new art teacher.
- Literacy curriculum review continues with the Curriculum Committee (RC/BC)

STAFFING

- Due to increases in students receiving Special Education services, we are hiring for a part time SPED teacher and a part-time Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP).
- We are also working to fill two long-call sub positions, 1 for SLP Jenny Dean, and 1 for EA Taylor Ryan (the former is set while the latter is ongoing)
- We are 19th on the waitlist for the Come *Teach in MN* grant. Initial schools have to use by Aug 1.

CULTURE

Field trips abound including trips to Crayola Experience, Minneapolis Institute of the Arts (MIA), and the
 Mill City Museum (MIA field trips as a result of bussing grant from Ms. Fox)
