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ACADEMICS

ALT CNA with MCA data revealed strong academic performance in a number of areas, outperforming state
and local comparison groups and rebounding from 2021 data. While pandemic impacts remain, strong
upticks in several areas speak to the quality of the in-person learning experience at Seven Hills.

STAFFING

CULTURE

• The Behavioral Systems Committee presented at workshops and we are adjusting the tone and tenor or our behavior systems for the K-5 programs across the LEA. This will highlight data tracking for staff and communications amongst staff and with families. Our approach will focus on restorative behavior practices that teach community skills that may be lagging and restore the relationship affected by the actions.
